



BSB (Release 7.0) Training Package Release

Dear Sydney College students

Many of you are studying a business qualification, for example, *BSB42415 Certificate IV in Marketing and Communication* or *BSB51918 Diploma of Leadership and Management*.

In Australia, the rules about what you must study in each qualification comes from a Training Package. A Training Package is a set of rules about the skills and knowledge you must achieve for each qualification and for each unit of competency inside each qualification. The qualification you are studying comes from the BSB Training Package.

In October 2020, an updated version of the BSB Training Package (Version 7.0) was released. The Australian Government has updated the BSB Training Package so that people entering the workforce with a business qualification have the skills that better meet today's business world.

All of Sydney College's business courses have been updated. The old qualification is called the 'superseded' qualification and the new qualification is called the 'current' qualification. If the current qualification has the same rules as the old qualification, it is 'equivalent'. If the current qualification does not follow the same rules as the as the old qualification, it is 'not equivalent'.

What do these changes mean for me?

- If you are starting a new qualification in Term 1, 2021, then you will graduate with the new (current) qualification at the end of your studies.
- If you are a pathway student and you are starting a new qualification in Term 1, 2021, then you may need to study extra units so that you graduate with the new (current) qualification. For example, if you completed *BSB42415 Certificate IV in Marketing and Communication* in Term 4, 2020, you will not start the old *BSB52415 Diploma of Marketing and Communication* in Term 1, 2021. Instead, you will start the new (current) qualification, *BSB50620 Diploma of Marketing and Communication* and you will need to complete two extra units.
- If you started a qualification in 2020 and you will finish this qualification by the end of Term 1, 2022, then you will graduate with the old qualification. For example, if you started *BSB51918 Diploma of Leadership and Management* in Term 1,2,3 or 4 2020, then you will graduate with the old qualification, *BSB51918*.
- If you have already been issued with a CoE for an old (superseded) qualification and you are moving to the new (current) qualification, then Sydney College will issue you with a new CE for the new qualification.

What do I need to do?

You don't have to do anything. Before the start of Term 1, 2021, Sydney College will send you a timetable with a list of units that you must study.

As always, you must complete your study hours and assessments for each unit of competency. You must be competent in all the units of your chosen course of study before you can graduate.
